Questioning

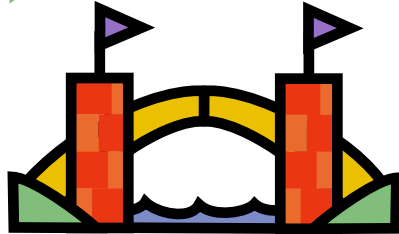
Ask questions to understand what I'm reading.

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Prior Knowledge

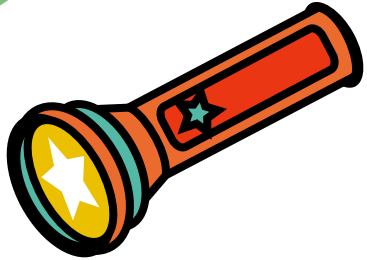
Use what I already know to help understand something new.

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Evaluating

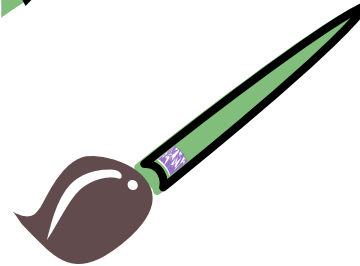
Make judgements about what I read and explain why.

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Visualizing

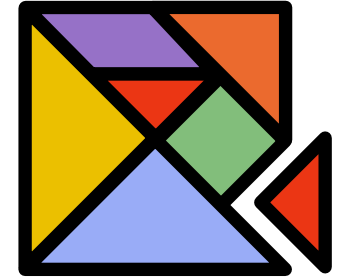
Create a movie in my mind while I'm reading.
