

Instructions for *Into the Book* Strategy Bookmarks

Bookmarks with *Into the Book* Actors

These bookmarks each feature one of the students from the *Into the Book* video series on one side, with one of the learning strategies on the other side. You can use them to remind students to use the strategies.

Print one copy of the bookmark *Fronts* and two copies of the bookmark *Backs*. You will have a few extra backs. Glue the fronts and backs to a piece of cardboard or cardstock to make a heavy duty bookmark. Or glue the two sides together and laminate.

To match the students with strategies you may use this key:

Bookmarks for students to personalize

Your students can put themselves *Into the Book* with their own strategy bookmarks. Print as many copies of the bookmark *Fronts* (4 per page) and bookmark *Backs* (8 on 2 pages) as you need for your class.

Students glue their own picture in the frame, and write in their favorite book, animal and board game. Then they choose a strategy for the back of the bookmark. This could be a strategy they are especially strong in, or one they need to remind themselves about when they read.

Glue the fronts and backs to a piece of cardboard or cardstock to make a heavy duty bookmark. Or glue the two sides together and laminate.
