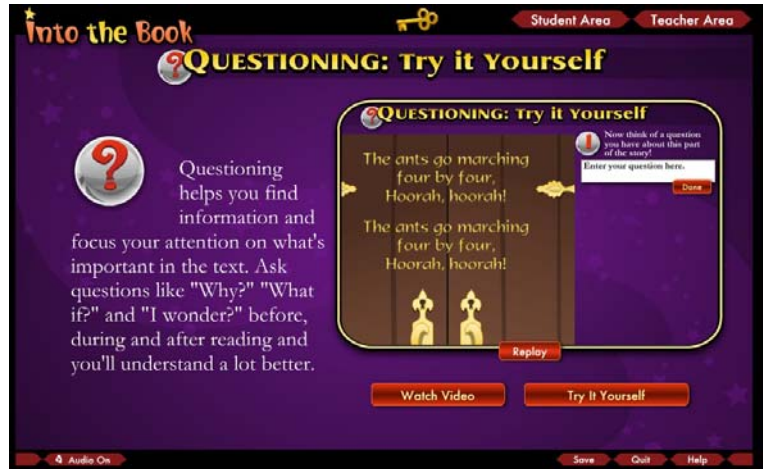


Screen-by-screen Preview: *Questioning*

- A quick animation shows you how to do the activity. *You can't click in this animation.*
- **Watch video button:** click to watch a short clip from *Into the Book* that reviews the strategy.
- **Try it Yourself button:** click to begin the activity.



- Click on a title to choose one of three folk tales.
- Students will have the opportunity to choose another tale after they finish the first.



- Think of a question about the title and cover illustration, and type it in the box.
- **Done button:** click to get a key to open the door to the next page of the story. *"Done" button will not appear until something has been typed in the box.*



Screen-by-screen Preview: *Questioning*

- Think of a new question for each page of the story.
- There are six pages (including the title) in each story.
- **Play** button: click to listen to that page of the story.

- If you find an answer to a previous question, click the question to type in an answer. Then click "Done."

- At the end of the story, check to see if any more questions can be answered.
- Questions that have been answered will appear purple.
- It's OK to leave some questions unanswered.

Screen-by-screen Preview: *Questioning*

- Sort questions: “In the book” or “In my head.”
- Drag questions to the correct column.
- Click on a truncated question to see the entire question.
- Done button: click to finish activity and tally points (appears after all questions have been sorted).



- Receive 1 point for each “In the book” question and 2 points for each “In my head” question.
- Why do you get more points for an “In my head” question? This is a great opportunity for a discussion after students have finished the activity.



- E-mail Questions and Answers: collect student work electronically, or e-mail parents to make a home-school connection.
- Listen to Questioning Song
- Print Bookmark and Questions: print to use for class discussion or portfolios.
- Read Another Story: repeat the activity with a different story.
